Wills, Trusts & Estates (DiRusso only)

Cumberland’s Academic Standards limit of registration to a maximum of four online credit hours in any term has been changed to meet the ABA’s changes to online limits. Beginning with the summer 2019 term, there is no longer a limit for enrollment in online course hours per term. However, a student cannot take more than 15 credit hours toward the 90 required for award of the J.D. degree for courses qualifying under this standard.

Courses that satisfy more than one requirement (ie. RE) students may use this course to satisfy only one requirement.

****Beginning with the Class of 2019, students must graduate with six (6) hours of experiential learning courses.**
